Other sections: 40 moves in 100 minutes. All moves in 2 hours. (i.e. clocks set back 20 minutes after Black's 40th move).

Players will be defaulted if not present within 30 minutes of start of round.

Entry Fees

Open: Entry fee £30 for ECF Gold members or FIDE-registered members of another national body. Other players must pay an additional £10 (Silver ECF members will be uprated to Gold).

Major, Intermediate and Minor. Entry fee £21.

Non-members of the ECF and Bronze members must pay an additional £7 (adults) or £5 (juniors). Bronze ECF members will be uprated to Silver.

For entries received after 30th April, add £3.

Discount for Juniors (Under 18 on 1st September 2016) £5 for each section.

MAJOR

First, second and third: £150, £125, and £90
Highest placed Somerset player will receive the Leon York memorial trophy.

INTERMEDIATE

First, second and third: £150, £125, and £90
Highest placed Somerset player will receive the Roy Hossell trophy.

MINOR

First, second and third: £150, £125, and £90
Highest placed Somerset player will receive the Cyril Chapman trophy. Highest placed ungraded Somerset player will receive the Jean Mackereth trophy.

Grading Prizes

There will be at least one grading prize in each section (dependent on entry).

This is a WECU designated British Championship qualifying event. Highest-placed eligible competitor in the Open Section, not already qualified, will be entitled to enter the 2017 British Championship. Additional qualifying place if Open entries exceed 19.

Team prize of £50 for the highest score by a genuine club team of 4 players.

All cash prizes are subject to the number of entries. Prizes will be forwarded within 14 days of the Congress. Except in the Open Tournament, an ungraded player may not win more than the value of the 3rd prize.
